


Consumer Insights During the COVID-19 Re-entry Period





When a vaccine for COVID-19 becomes available, which of the following best describes your approach?






How worried are you that another pandemic will happen in your lifetime?

How has COVID-19 altered your approach to grocery shopping going forward?

- 1. I will be doing more shopping at smaller, specialty markets 8% Down 1% from Wave 7
- 2. I will be delegating one person to do the shopping instead of having multiple people in my household shopping together **12%** Down 2% from Wave 7
- 3. I will be doing more grocery delivery than I was prior to COVID-19 17% up 1% from Wave 7
- 4. I will be doing more curbside pickup than I was prior to COVID-19 21% Up 3% from Wave 7
- 5. I will be doing my grocery shopping at one store instead of multiple stores 25% Down 5% from Wave 7
- 6. I will be buying more groceries in one trip so that I don't have to go as often 47% Down 8% from Wave 7
